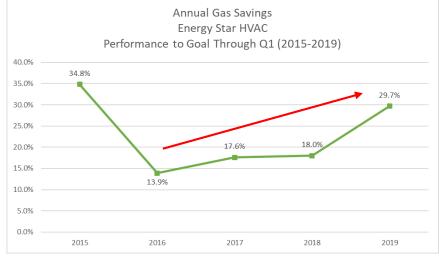


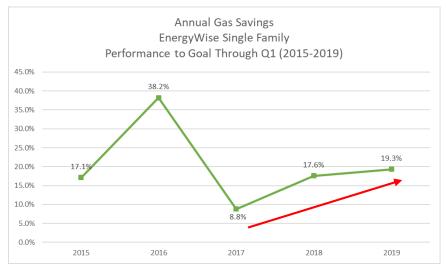


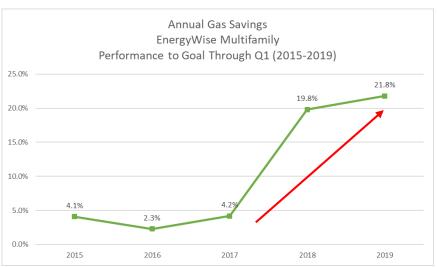
# Residential Gas Programs

Progress towards savings goals through Q1 has increased year over year for the last several years

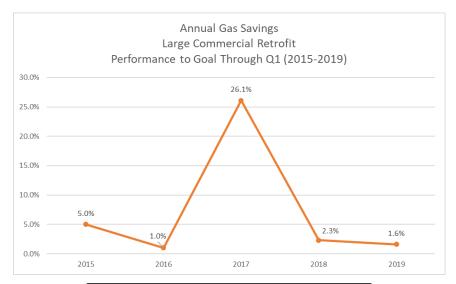


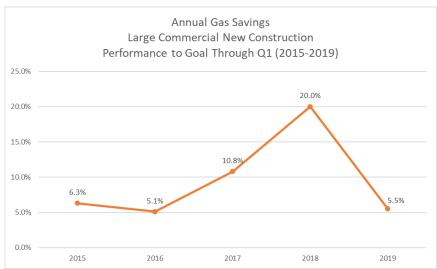






## **C&I Gas Programs**





Large Retrofit program makes up ~74% of planned C&I savings

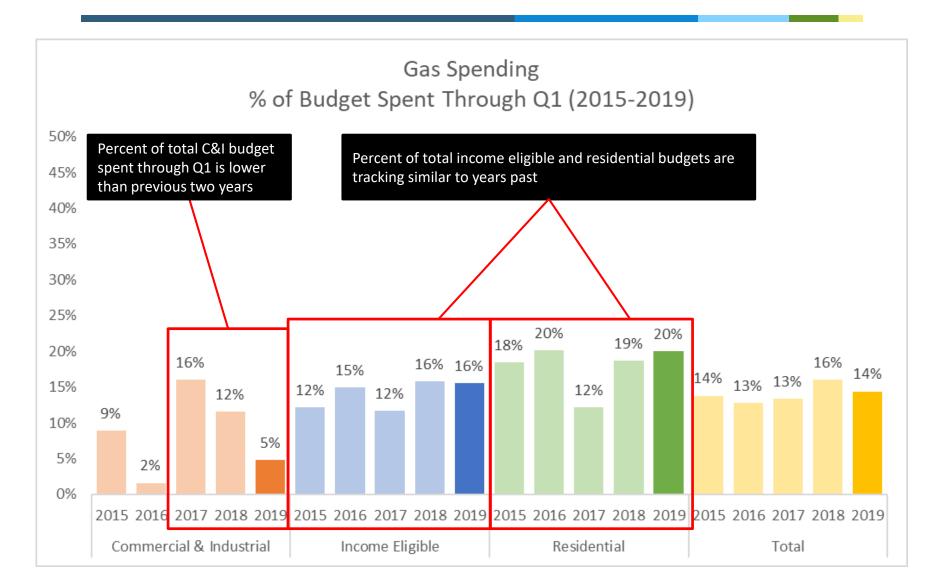
Progress through Q1 similar to previous years disregarding 2017 anomaly

Progress through Q1 has been slower than it was in each of the past two years

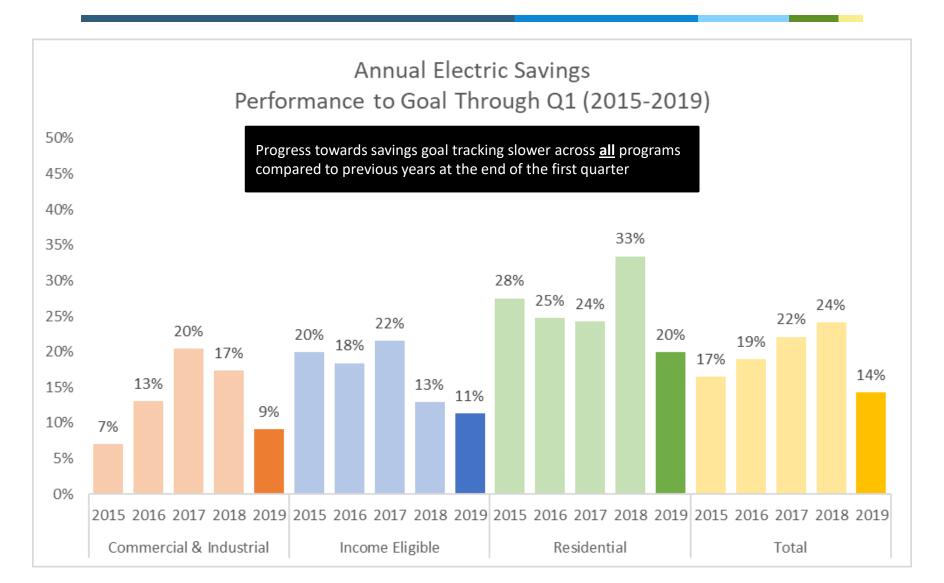

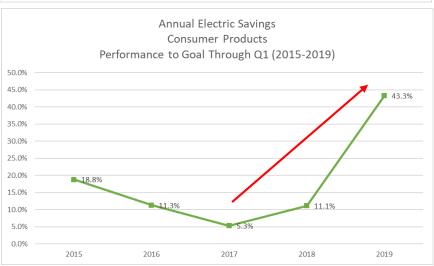




Progress towards savings goals through Q1 has decreased year over year for the last several years for HVAC and EW SF Programs
