

## **Reason for SRP**



#### Reason for SRP

To identify alternative solutions as **customer and grid-side opportunities** that are **safe** and **reliable**, **prudent**, **environmentally responsible**, **cost-effective**, and provide the path to **lower supply and delivery costs** to customers in Rhode Island.

- ➤ The Company primarily carries this out through the proposal and implementation of Non-Wires Alternative (NWA) projects in SRP.
- > NWA is the inclusive term for any electrical grid investment that defers or removes the need to construct or upgrade an electrical system.

NWAs are the core component of SRP

#### **Differences between Plans**



- NWAs align with the Least-Cost Procurement (LCP) statute (§ 39-1-27.7)
- Do not fall within the Infrastructure, Safety and Reliability (ISR) Plan




- NWAs are an integral part of reliability and distribution system planning
- Do not fall within the Energy Efficiency Program (EEP) Plan




- NWAs are alternative solutions to address targeted electrical system needs
- Not "traditional" distribution system work
- Do not approach the electrical system in the same bulk-level manner as energy efficiency






