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Background

- Technical Working Group Meetings in Dec. 2018 and Feb. 2019 discussed revisions to planning process to give more visibility into proposed changes to Stakeholders.
- New process highlighted by C-Team at the February EERMC.
- Several Key Dates to note:
- 1. Plan Outline Memorandum (Outline) is issued for the first time, on June 10th.
- 2. First draft of the plan is moved up one month early, to July 16th.
- 3. Second draft is added for distribution to Stakeholders on August 23rd.
- 4. As in prior years, final draft is circulated September 19th.

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Purpose

- The Outline was created to give Stakeholders more visibility into the areas of focus in the 2020 Annual Plan as early as possible in the planning process.
- It is does NOT represent all topics that will be covered. It is simply meant to
 identify major themes or topics put forward by the Company or raised by multiple
 parties during the stakeholder presentation process.
- Measure level details and recommendations by the C-team will be discussed throughout the drafting and are not included in the Outline.
- While the Outline shows the proposed layout of the Plan, the formatting within sections may be consolidated and refined to be more accessible to the reader.

- In order to meet this schedule, Stakeholders at the EE Technical Working Group presented on topics they would like to see addressed in the 2020 Annual Plan.
