

Evaluate and make recommendations with regard to the optimization of energy efficiency, energy conservation, energy resource development; and the development of a plan for least-cost procurement for Rhode Island



Engage Stakeholders

Provide consistent, comprehensive, informed and publicly accountable stakeholder involvement in energy efficiency, energy conservation, and energy resource management



Monitor and Evaluate

Monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of programs to achieve energy efficiency, energy conservation, and diversification of energy resources



Ensure Public Benefit

Promote public understanding of energy issues and of ways in which energy efficiency, energy conservation, and energy resource diversification and management can be effectuated

EERMC members commit to:


- Serve a 5-year term




Least-Cost Procurement: Timeline & Milestones
