Question and Response:

1. *Last year the council (EERMC) mentioned it had a budgetary restriction of \$45,000 towards the K-12 Energy Curriculum Training which included the NEED licensing fees. This year, is there a funding cap on K-12 Energy Curriculum Training and Public Education Event Planning & Outreach?*

The Council has budgeted \$40,000 for K-12 energy curriculum training in 2022. However, final contracted funding will be allocated based on the selected proposal. A bidder must submit one total cost for all proposed training activities in their cost proposal. To allow comparisons between proposals with differing lengths and quantities of trainings, all bidders must also include hourly pricing (cost per hour of training) in their cost proposal through the Cost Proposal – Task Sheets form.
