Enclosed herewith for filing please find an original and nine (9) copies of the following document:

1. Energy Efficiency & Resource Management Council's Revised November 22, 2022 Council Budget Table.

To summarize, the changes are as follows:

- Updated 2023 budget for the Public Forum & Lecture Series (2022) item to reflect the 2022 Budget which is a known contract amount. This increases the 2023 proposed budget for this item by \$2,524.14 from \$22,500.00 to \$25,024.14;
- Remove proposed 2023 budget for the K-12 Energy Education (2022) item. This decreases the 2023 proposed budget for this item from \$40,000.00 to \$0;
- Net impact is a \$37,475.86 decrease in the Public Education budget from \$152,500.00 to \$115,024.14; and
- Net impact is a \$37,475.86 decrease in the total 2023 budget proposal from \$1,133,775.00 to \$1,096,299.14.
