## Process for Updating LCP Standards

March 31<sup>st</sup>: Public Utilities Commission (PUC) proposed initial set of revisions in Docket 23-07-EE

April 6<sup>th</sup>: PUC held a Technical Session to review its proposed revisions

April 21<sup>st</sup>: Stakeholders submitted written comments to the PUC

**Ongoing:** PUC incorporating minor changes suggested by stakeholder comments

**TBD:** PUC to distribute updated draft of LCP Standards and provide deadline for Stakeholders to provide additional input



Next Steps

Depending on timeline, remaining stakeholder input may be due prior to June Council meeting

- C-Team proposed process for providing feedback on behalf of Council
  - Review updated draft to identify which of its comments/proposed redlines were incorporated
  - Provide comments in support of OER's equity and climate change related comments/redlines
  - Provide comments on concept of moving to a binding Three-Year plan, consistent with Council discussion on LEAD session
