**RE: Docket 086 - National Grid Electric and Gas Energy Efficiency Programs
2013 Year-End Report - Revised**

Dear Ms. Masaro:

Enclosed please find ten (10) copies of National Grid's¹ Revised 2013 Energy Efficiency Year-End Report. The Company initially filed its 2013 Energy Efficiency Year-End Report on May 1, 2014. Following its May 1 filing, the Company determined that adjustments were needed to savings and spending from that which were reported in the original filing, as further discussed below. A copy of this report has also been provided to the parties in this docket.

In addition, this letter serves to notify the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) regarding the Company's intended use for the 2013 Year-End electric load balance in accordance with Section 3.8 of the 2014 Energy Efficiency Program Plan (2014 Plan).

Revised Year-End Report

As a result of a review of electric and gas savings parameters for selected measures by the Company's Massachusetts affiliate in preparation for their year-end filing, the Company identified certain corrections to analogous measures in Rhode Island. This resulted in an adjustment to savings in Rhode Island. At the same time, the Company identified one additional data entry correction to savings for one project. The overall impact of the adjustments on savings results in a decrease of 1,914 Annual MWh, approximately 1.2%, in the electric portfolio and an increase of 561 MMBtu, approximately 0.2%, in the gas portfolio.

Electric and gas spending were also adjusted as a result of an internal financial review. This review - which was ongoing at the time the Company filed its 2013 Year-End Report - identified discrepancies in the amounts reported on new loans and loan repayments for the electric Commercial and Industrial revolving loan funds. This review identified that some new loans and loan repayments were not applied properly to the revolving loan funds. As a result, electric program (2220222) were overstated. The Company has made the appropriate adjustments to the Year-End electric load balance in 2013. These adjustments resulted in a higher 2013 Year-End electric load balance than previously projected in the Energy Efficiency Program Plan
